 1. general urinalysis with microscopic evaluation of sediment;
 2. quantitative protein determination;
 3. quantitative glucose determination;
 4. quantitative calcium determination;
 5. quantitative amylase determination.
 - 4. Stool tests:**
 1. general examination;
 2. parasites;
 3. occult blood - by immunochemical method.
 - 5. Coagulation tests:**
 1. prothrombin index (INR);
 2. kaolin-kephalin time (APTT);
 3. fibrinogen.
 - 6. Microbiological tests:**
 1. urine culture with antibiogram;
 2. throat swab culture;
 3. general stool culture for Salmonella; Shigella;
 4. C-reactive protein (CRP)
 - 7. Spirometry.**
 - 8. Resting Electrocardiography (ECG) test.**
 - 9. Ultrasound examinations (USG):**
 1. ultrasound of the abdomen and retroperitoneal space, including initial prostate gland assessment,
 2. ultrasound of the thyroid and parathyroid glands;
 3. ultrasound of the salivary glands;
 4. ultrasound of the kidneys, urinary tubes, bladder;
 5. ultrasound of peripheral lymph nodes.
 - 10. X-ray examinations:**
 1. chest X-ray in AP and lateral view;
 2. bone X-rays: spine; limbs and pelvis in AP and lateral views;
 3. X-ray of the skull and sinuses in AP and lateral views;
 4. overview X-ray of the abdominal cavity.
 - 11. Endoscopic examinations:**
 1. gastroscopy;
 2. colonoscopy.
